## Commission Action on Proposed Regulation Changes R.67-206, R.67-411, and R.67-1507

At the Commission's monthly business meeting on October 13, 2025, the South Carolina Workers' Compensation Commission approved the proposed language for Regulation 67-206 (providing the procedure for a claimant to file a claim with the Commission) and Regulation 67-1507 (allowing a self-insurer the opportunity to obtain an irrevocable letter of credit to comply with the security requirement under § 42-5-20).

The notices of proposed regulation have been submitted to the Legislative Council for publication in the State Register. The Commission shall hold a public hearing and opportunity for public comment during the January 2026 business meeting. Interested parties may submit comments for consideration by the Commission in advance of the meeting to: Gary M. Cannon, Executive Director.

The Commission voted to withdraw the proposed changes to R.67-411. The proposed amendment to this regulation was recommended by the House Legislative Oversight Committee in the 2024 HLOC study. Due to relevant legal analysis offered by our stakeholders, the Commission will seek additional clarification from the Committee relating to the intent of the amendment.
