Commission Approved 7Applications to Self-Insure

The Commission approved applications to self-insure seven (7) prospective members of three (3) funds, and one application to self-insure for worker's compensation.

Received Agency Departmental Reports

The Department Directors and Executive Director reviewed their monthly reports submitted to the Commission prior to the meeting.

Commission Approves Suspension Order for KERMIT system.

Implementation of the new claims management system (KERMIT) will require eCase and Progress to be taken offline prior to the new system going live. During the time the system is offline the Commission will migrate data from the old system to the new and verify the validity of the data transferred. Activity on a claim may impute the integrity of the data transferred and prevent an accurate validation. Therefore, it is necessary to deny stakeholder access to the system during this period.
